*Veterans Memorial Library's history continued...*In 1953 plans for refinancing and constructing a new library were studied by community leaders. Money from a special library building fund, municipal court funds, a postwar building fund and a loan from other municipal funds were put together, and with the old church building literally falling down, a new library building was placed into service in April of 1957. Not only was there a new building, but also a new name as well. On May 24th, 1957, the library was dedicated to Mt. Pleasant veterans of all wars - Veterans Memorial Library. *Read more as we get closer to the big day...*
